Campus Development Plan of Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University:

Phase 1: Infrastructure Development and starting NEP 2020 with UG Program (Year 1-3)

1. **Construction of Administrative Block:** A central administrative block will be constructed to house the administrative offices, faculty rooms, and staff facilities. It will also include conference rooms, a library, and a resource center.
2. **Academic Buildings:** Three academic buildings will be constructed to house the schools, departments, and centers. These buildings will have state-of-the-art classrooms, laboratories, and specialized facilities for each program.
