

### Vice Chancellor's Report

Welcome to the Annual Report of the University for the year 2020-21. Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University (SASU) was established by the Government of Assam as a State University with the primary objective to promote education, research, and outreach activities in the cusp areas of sports & physical education along with its allied fields. This report is an account of various activities during 2020-21.



**UGC Recognition:** Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University started functioning on 22nd June 2020 after joining of the first Vice Chancellor, Prof. J. P. Verma. Immediately the University applied for recognition to the UGC for empowering the University to award its own degrees. On 5th February 2021, the UGC recognized the University vide its letter No. F.No.9-9/2020(CPP-I/PU) in its 2(f) categories and authorized the University to award its own degree and start the Ph.D. programs.

**Academics:** The Academic session of this new University was launched on 21st January 2021 by organizing a brief ceremony in which the message of the Hon'ble Chancellor of the University Prof. Jagdish Mukhi and Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam Sri Sarbananda Sonowal were read. The University started its first academic program in the month of January 2021 in the form of one year Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Coaching. In all, 9(nine) students were admitted through all India advertisements. This diploma program was started in Athletics and Football. Besides the faculty drawn from DIET, visiting faculty from the Universities like the Central University of Haryana, NSNIS Patiala, and Dibrugarh University were engaged in conducting this program.

**Student's activities:** The students of the first course of the University organized the Saraswati Puja celebration on 16th February 2021 in the study centre of the University established in Dibrugarh University.

**Infrastructure:** The University has been allotted 200 bigha land in Chabua for the construction of the University. As of now, the University's administrative office is operated from the 2nd floor of the District Industries and Commerce Centre Building, Dibrugarh whereas its academic programs are being carried out in its study centre established on the Dibrugarh University campus. In the administrative office, 5(five) rooms have been allotted by the Government of Assam in which the office of the Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Finance & Accounts Officer, and other offices have been established. In the study centre Dibrugarh University has allowed us to use three rooms on their campus for running our academic programs.



**Outreach activities:** Along with the academic activities, the University is engaged in outreach activities through its Extension Services Unit. The following programs were organised as outreach activities.

To fulfill this dream the University signed an MoU with the INFLIBNET (an organization of UGC, New Delhi, Ministry of Education Govt. of India) for designing, developing, hosting, and maintaining a website of the University along with the development of an online platform for various University activities such as online admission system, faculty life cycle, staff profile, student lifecycle (admissions, academics, student admin services), expert panel database, academic management system, examination portal, online payment system, the online platform for LOGO / Flag design competition, learning management system, placement cell, and alumni management. These systems are proposed to be developed, commissioned, and maintained in a phased manner during the three-year time frame.

### SRI SRI ANIRUDDHADEVA SPORTS UNIVERSITY: AT A GLANCE

Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University is named after a great Vaishnava saint who was a social reformer in Assam during the medieval period. This is the first Sports University of Assam established by the State Government in the city of Chabua, Dibrugarh. The University is focused on quality education in the area of sports sciences, physical education, and its allied areas. It was established by the Act of Assam Legislative Assembly (No. LGL. 164/2018/7) which received the assent of the Hon'ble Governor of Assam on 10th December 2018.

The primary aim of this University is to prepare top-tier sports scientists, physical educationists, sports coaches, and high-class researchers in the area of sport psychology, exercise science, sports biomechanics, sports medicine, sports physiotherapy, health education, sports technology, and sports analytics. The University intends to prepare professionals as well as sports entrepreneurs keeping in mind the competitive global job market.

The University also plans to create world-level infrastructures for training elite athletes for enhancing medal tallies for India in International sports competitions. At the same time, it intends to reach out to the people of Assam and neighbouring states for garnering untapped talent. Through its outreach programs, the University will be encouraging the masses to be physically active and making sports a way of life. Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University intends to be at the epicenter of sports development in Assam and help the state contribute to India becoming the sporting powerhouse of the world.

The campus is proposed to be constructed with green buildings for maximizing environmental, economic, and social benefits in order to enhance and protect biodiversity and ecosystems with improved air and water quality, and reduced waste streams to conserve and restore natural resources.

The Assam Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University Act, 2018 (Assam Act No. XXIX of 2018) came into force and became functional w.e.f. from the date of the joining of Prof. J.P. Verma, the first Vice Chancellor of Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University on 22nd June 2020 through notification no. SYW.182/2019/93, dated 24th December 2020.

The University has also been included in the list of the Universities established as per section 2 (f) of the UGC Act, 1956, and is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956.

This Annual Report of the University contains the details about the University its functioning authorities and the major events and announcements made during the year 2020-21 (April 2020 to March 2021).





### **OBJECTIVES**

- 1. To evolve as an institute of advanced studies in the field of Physical Education and Sports Sciences.
- 2. To provide for research and development and dissemination of knowledge in Physical Education and Sports Sciences by providing specially designed academic and training programs in various areas of physical education and sports sciences and training in advanced technologies of Sports.
- 3. To strengthen physical education and sports training programs to promote sports including traditional sports and games.
- 4. To establish centres and institutions of excellence for imparting state-of-the-art educational training and research in the fields of physical education and sports sciences, sports technology, and high-performance training for all sports and games.
- 5. To provide professional and academic leadership to other institutions in the field of physical education and sports sciences.
- 6. To provide vocational guidance and placement services in physical education, sports sciences, sports medicine, sports technology, and other related fields.
- 7. To generate capabilities for the development of knowledge, skills, and competencies at various levels in the fields of physical education and sports sciences, sports technology, and high-performance training for all sports and games.
- 8. To generate capabilities to provide the infrastructure of international standards for education, training, and research in the areas related to physical education and sports sciences, sports technology, and high-performance training for all sports and games.
- 9. To prepare highly qualified professionals in the fields of physical education and sports sciences, sports technology, and high-performance training for all sports and games.
- 10. To serve as a Centre of Excellence for the elite and other talented sportspersons of all sports and games and innovation in physical education and sports sciences and to carry out, encourage and propagate research.
- 11. To function as a leading resource center for knowledge and development in the areas of physical education and sports sciences, sports technology, and high-performance training for all sports and games.
- 12. To provide international and national collaboration in the fields of physical education and sports sciences, sports technology, and high-performance training for all sports and games.
- 13. To establish close linkage with sports academies, schools, colleges, sports and recreation clubs, sports associations, and international and national federations for the purpose of teaching, training, and research in physical education and sports sciences, sports technology, and high-performance training for all sports and games.
- 14. To train talented athletes so as to help them to evolve into elite athletes of the international level.
- 15. To make Assam become a sporting power.
- 16. Such other objects, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, which the State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, specify on this behalf.



### **GOVERNANCE STRUCTURES**

As per the Act, the University has a multi-level governing structure for taking various strategic, operational, academic, and financial decisions through its authorities like the Court, Executive Council, Academic & Activity Council, Finance Committee and Board of Sports Studies, and such other authorities as may be declared by the Statutes to be the authorities of the University.

#### The Court

The Court is the apex body of the University and has the following powers and functions:

- (a) To review from time to time, the broad policies and programs of the University and to suggest measures for the improvement and development of the University.
- (b) To consider and pass resolutions on the annual report, audit reports, the annual accounts of the University, and statement of financial estimates for the succeeding year.
- (c) To advise the State Government in respect of any matter which may be referred to it for advice.
- (d) To perform such other functions as may be prescribed by the Statutes.

#### The Executive Council

The Executive Council is the Chief Executive Authority of the University and, as such, has all powers necessary to administer the University subject to the provisions of this Act and the Statutes made there under; and may make Regulations for that purpose.

After joining of Prof. J.P. Verma as the first Vice Chancellor on 22nd June 2020 and completing two weeks of mandatory quarantine in Guwahati, he reached Dibrugarh and stayed in the Guest house of Dibrugarh University. By using the transitory power of the first Vice-Chancellor as per Article 45 (5) of the Act, Vice Chancellor constituted a temporary committee to exercise and perform the power and duties on behalf of the Executive Council by nominating the following members:

Accordingly, the first adhoc Executive Council meeting took place on 22nd July, 2020 in which many decisions were taken to make the university functional.

Further, as per the Article 45 (1) of the Assam Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University Act, 2018, the Vice Chancellor in consultation with the State Government submitted the draft proposal for constituting the first Executive Council to the Government of Assam under the transitory power of the first Vice Chancellor since the Statute of the University was not notified by the Government of Assam. Accordingly, the Government of Assam vide letter no. SYW 135/2018/28 dated 31st July 2020 constituted the first Executive Council is duly constituted as per the Statutes of the University which is yet to be notified by the Government of Assam.:

### The Academic & Activity Council

The Academic and Activity Council is the highest academic body of the University and is responsible for the maintenance of standards of instruction, education, and examination within the University. It has the right to advise the various Academic schools on all academic matters.

As per the transitory power of the first Vice Chancellor of the University as per Article 45 (5) of the Assam Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University Act, 2018 an adhoc committee of the Academic and Activity Council was constituted temporarily to exercise and perform any of the power and duties of Academic and Activity Council with the below mentioned members by the University as per the provisions of the Act vide notification no. SASU/CHB/30/2020, dated 23/09/2020 until such time the Academic and Activity Council is duly constituted as per the Statutes of the University which is yet to be notified by the Government of Assam.

### The Finance Committee

### **ACADEMIC PROFILE**

The Academic Profile consists of the details about the program being offered by the University during the year 2020-21. It also details about implementing the courses offered during the year and details of the Faculty who taught these courses.

### Academic Programs of the University

The first academic program of the University with the title **"Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Coaching"** (Two Semester Programme) was launched in January 2021. This program was of 46 credits. The program was designed to prepare coaches and trainers in different sports disciplines. The course provides a clear understanding of the scientific techniques, strategies, and specific knowledge in the chosen discipline to the students. This program aims at providing opportunities to the students to enhance and develop their quality in professional practice and prepare them for high-performance coaching at par with world-class coaches. The curriculum has been designed to prepare high-quality sports coaches and physical fitness trainers in various games/sports with micro specializations, in order to cater to the ever-increasing demand of our Indian society and to uplift the standards of Indian sport.

### **Assessment System**

The University prepared a detailed Academic Regulation for running all the academic programs at the University. Assessment System was developed by using the Grading System and Grade Cards were issued to the candidates showing the Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) and Cumulative



Grade Point Average (CGPA). The University has developed the formats for issuing the Grade Cards, Transcripts to the successful candidates as per the NEP 2020 guidelines.

In order to conduct this diploma program, the services of many Visiting Faculty were taken. These Visiting Faculty were drawn from the Central University of Haryana, NS NIS Patiala, and Dibrugarh University.

However, only the post of Vice Chancellor has been filled up whereas the Registrar has been provided by the Govt. of Assam on deputation, and the Finance & Accounts Officer was provided by the Govt. of Assam on an attachment basis. Sri Sanjoy Dutta, ACS was posted as the first Registrar of the University by the Government of Assam on deputation vide letter no. AAA.20/2017/51, dated 4th June 2020 and vide letter no. AAA.30/2014/111 dated 8th September 2020 and SYW.121/2020/ 37 dated 16th September 2020, whereas the services of Shri Gunajit Medhi, AFS, were provided to the University as a Finance and Accounts Officer on attachment basis vide office order no SYW.122/ 2020/35 dated 30th June 2020, and vide Finance Department's Notification No. FEB.51/2020/1(B/ S) dated 23rd June 2020.

#### **Proposal for Creating Teaching and Non-Teaching Positions**

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In addition to the above-sanctioned posts, a proposal for sanctioning the following teaching positions for running the academic program of SASU was sent to the Government of Assam.

In addition to the above, a proposal to create 37 more posts (teaching and non-teaching) was submitted to the Govt. for urgent recruitment vide this office letter No. SASU/CHB/20/2020/38 dated 14th October 2020.

### UPDATES ON CAMPUS CONSTRUCTION

The Government of Assam has allotted 200 bighas (approx) of land for Sri Sri Anirudhadeva Sports University, Chabua, Dibrugarh, Assam. This University has been planned for 2500 students strength with different educational and sports courses/programs/activities. The Vision Document of the University and detailed infrastructure plan have been prepared by the University showing details of various academic facilities, sports infrastructure, residential accommodation, hostel facilities, utilities, etc. The University will have water bodies that will add beauty to the campus. It has been proposed to plant decorative plants on both sides of the campus roads.

The proposed campus of the University at Chabua shall be modern and will have state-of-the-art following the path of sustainability while being comfortable and efficient for the occupants and visitors alike. The master plan of this project emphasizes sustainability and environmental sensitivity at all levels. It will further exemplify rational approaches to the construction of a new campus in an unspoiled rural setting. Once completed the campus is likely to emerge as one of the best campuses with green technology in the State.

The Govt. of Assam had approved Rs. 16.3509 crore (Rupees Sixteen crore thirty-five lakh nine thousand) only for raising low site (earth filling), construction of boundary wall, Gate, RCC Covered drain, box culvert, and topographical survey works.

The Chief Engineer, PWD (Building), Assam already floated a tender for Rs. 14.8 crores as per the direction from the Directorate of Sports & Youth Department vide ref No. T/ BD/22/2020/04.

### FUTURE ACTIVITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

The University proposed to work on four different verticals as listed below to fulfill its objectives:

### **Teaching and Research**

The main objective of this sports University shall be the knowledge creation in the area of Sports Science, Physical Education, and its allied areas at par with the global standards for acceptability of our trained professionals worldwide. The focus would be on creating a conducive environment for conducting high-level research and providing consultancy to all stakeholders for becoming financially self-sufficient and making a healthy and productive society.

### **Elite Sports Development**

The sports and other infrastructures in the University are proposed to be at par with world standards so as to provide specialized training to the athletes. The University will have the club models prevalent in different countries to develop high-performing athletes. The sports infrastructures so created in the University will be utilized after the scheduled classes of the University programs by the clubs in different sports to train the elite sports persons for competing in the top-class tournaments for enhancing medal tallies of the country. These clubs will have mentors as top-class coaches and decorated sportspersons with medals. The University will encourage industries for sponsoring these sports clubs.

#### **Nurturing Sporting Talents**

The University will start summer camps on the campus for the children starting from seven years onward to expose the different sports activities. After screening those children having sporting talents will be given admission to sports academies in different sports in which their sporting skills



will be nurtured throughout the year. Talent election in different sports shall be done by using a scientific system of screening using the software. One such system has been developed indigenously known as Talent Identification System in Sports the glimpse of which can be seen at www.tiss.net.in. Several other measures will be incorporated in different schools of Assam for nurturing sporting talents in different sports.

#### **Community Sports and Fitness for Healthy Society**

To encourage Community Sports and motivate people to stay fit several initiatives shall be made by the University. Such measures include providing sporting infrastructure in different communities for encouraging people to play, developing existing parks in different cities as fitness parks managed in PPP mode, adopting villages, and running community radio. The University will provide the manpower to different centers for coaching different sports at the community level. Several skill development programs in the area of aerobics, fitness center management, fitness training, sports nutrition, sports medicine, sports analytics, yoga, sports journalism, etc. shall be initiated in the University for making the incumbent an entrepreneur.
