JOINING OF VICE-CHANCELLOR



Prof. J. P. Verma joined Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University as its founder Vice-Chancellor on 22nd June 2020. After joining the position, Prof. Verma met the Hon'ble Sarbananda Sonowal Ji, the Chief Minister of Assam in his office in Guwahati. During the discussions about the development of the university, Hon'ble Chief Minister briefed that 200 Bigha land has been acquired in the Chabua district of Dibrugarh in which the university shall be established. 72nd Republic Day Celebration

The 72nd republic day celebration was held in the Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University on 26th January 2021. This is the first republic day celebration by the university after its establishment in June 2020. The constitution was prepared in 2 years, 11 months and 18 days and took six months to write it. While preparing the constitution neither typing nor printing was used. Prem Bihari Narayan Raizada wrote the original copy on parchment which would last for 1000 years and cannot be destroyed by microbes like bacteria, or termite. After sharing such a precious information Prof. Verma said that the Republic Day in India is of great importance in history as it explains every struggle of Indian freedom fighters. Unity in diversity is the fundamental identity of this country. He said that we are all proud that we are the citizens of such a constitutional nation.

Towards the end of his speech, he said that let us take pledge that we all will work for the development of this country the way it is possible and make this country a shining example in the world.

RESEARCH & BOOK PUBLICATION

Prof. J. P. Verma, the Vice Chancellor of the university published a book titled, *Determining Sample Size and Power in Research Studies: A Manual for Researchers*. This book has been published by Springer, Germany in 2020. The book is meant for the researchers of data driven disciplines to improve the quality and authenticity of research findings. In an empirical study, researchers are interested to see the effect of a policy intervention on some outcome of interest based on a collected data sample. When the sample is large, even a small effect due to implementation of a policy shows a significant result whereas in a small sample even a large effect may not be significant. Hence, researchers are in a dilemma as to what should be the optimum sample size. When determining the sample size, the two parameters of interest are: how big the effect of a policy ought to be, and with how much confidence can we say that this effect will hold when the policy is implemented in other areas. In this book, the authors have presented methods to determine what should be the sample size in any research study based on the above two considerations. If the sample size cannot be increased or decreased, then one can report as to how much is the power in his/her research study. If these are not reported in a research paper, top tiered journals are very likely to reject the paper for publication. Hence this book aims to promote rigorous research methods for better quality of research output .
