ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AT A GLANCE

1. Five-Year Integrated Masters (4-year UG + 1 Year PG) in Physical Education and Sports

The Five-Year Integrated Postgraduate Programme (FYIPGP) in Physical Education and Sports is a comprehensive academic programme designed to provide in-depth knowledge, practical skills, and research competence in a selected area of specialisation. The programme integrates undergraduate and postgraduate studies into a continuous learning pathway, ensuring academic progression, skill development, and professional readiness.

Students are exposed to theoretical foundations, practical applications, internships, and research projects, enabling them to develop expertise and critical-thinking skills. The programme prepares graduates for careers in academia, research, industry, and professional practice.

2. Sports Analytics and Mathematical Statistics

This undergraduate programme provides rigorous training in mathematical statistics with a strong orientation towards sports analytics, data science, and performance evaluation. It is aligned with UGC regulations and NEP-2020, emphasizing flexibility, employability, and research readiness. Upon completion of this programme, students will be able to apply mathematical and statistical reasoning to solve theoretical and applied problems. Analyze sports and real-world data using appropriate statistical models. Use statistical software and programming tools effectively. Demonstrate ethical reasoning, research aptitude, and communication skills. Pursue higher education, research, or professional careers in statistics and analytics

3. Sports Psychology

The Five-Year Integrated Post Graduate Programme in Sports Psychology (Four Years Bachelor's Programme + One Year PG) aims to develop knowledgeable, skilled, and ethically responsible professionals capable of understanding, analysing, and enhancing human performance in sports and physical activity through psychological principles. The programme provides a strong foundation in general psychology, human behaviour, research methods, sports sciences, and applied sports psychology. It equips students with competencies in motivation, mental training, performance enhancement, counselling, emotional regulation, team dynamics, and athlete well-being. Through an interdisciplinary approach combining psychology, physiology, sociology, and sports science, learners gain the ability to evaluate performance variables, design psychological interventions, interpret data, and apply evidence-based practices in real sports environments. The programme further seeks to nurture critical thinking, research capability, leadership, and professional ethics, empowering graduates to work in educational institutions, sports academies, hospitals, fitness centres, professional sports teams, and research organizations, while contributing meaningfully to the advancement of sports performance and athlete mental health.

4. Sports Management

The Five-Year Integrated Post Graduate Programme in Sports Management is designed to develop competent professionals with a strong foundation in sports management, business principles, and interdisciplinary knowledge relevant to the sports industry. The programme aims to equip students with theoretical understanding and practical skills in areas such as sports marketing, event management, governance, economics, and communication. It emphasizes the development of analytical thinking, leadership abilities, ethical values, and decision-making skills necessary for managing sports organizations and events effectively. 5. Sports Journalism

7. Yogic Science and Naturopathy

Yogic Science and Naturopathy are traditional systems of health and wellness that focus on maintaining harmony between the body, mind, and spirit through natural methods. Yogic Science is based on the ancient practice of Yoga, which includes physical postures (asanas), breathing exercises (pranayama), meditation, and ethical disciplines to improve physical fitness, mental peace, and spiritual well-being. Naturopathy, on the other hand, is a drugless healing system that believes in the body's natural ability to heal itself through proper diet, fasting, hydrotherapy, exercise, sunlight, and natural therapies. Both systems emphasize prevention of diseases, healthy lifestyle habits, stress management, and holistic health. Today, Yogic Science and Naturopathy are widely recognized for promoting overall wellness and improving quality of life naturally.

8. Sports Technology And Computer Application

This post-graduate programme in Sports Technology and Computer Application aims to provide students with a strong foundation in sports science, engineering principles, and modern computing technologies used in the sports industry. The programme seeks to equip learners with practical skills in programming, data analytics, wearable sensor technologies, and sports equipment design, enabling them to understand and improve athletic performance through technological solutions. It also focuses on developing critical thinking, problem-solving abilities, and professional communication skills required in a rapidly growing field of sports technology. Through hands-on laboratory work, industry internships, and project-based learning, the programme prepares students to work confidently in areas such as sports analytics, sports engineering, software development for sports applications, and technology-driven sports management. Overall, the programme aims to produce graduates who can integrate technology with sports to create innovative solutions for athletes, teams, and the sports industry.

The Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Coaching (Specialization in •Football, Volleyball, Track & Field, Badminton, Boxing and Weight Lifting) is a professional programme designed to develop skilled Track and Field coaches. It focuses on skills, tactics, fitness, and performance analysis while integrating scientific understanding of sports training with useful coaching methods. The course prepares students for careers in coaching and sports development by encouraging moral behavior, leadership, and holistic growth.

10. Post Graduate Diploma in Yoga Education

The one-year Post Graduate Diploma in Yoga Education is specifically designed for candidates who have a flair for yoga and wish to opt for the coaching profession as a career. The course will provide an opportunity to acquire the minimum qualification deemed essential for training/coaching at the beginner and intermediate levels. The curriculum is designed so as to cater to the ever-increasing demand for trained yoga coaches to identify and train potential people through a scientific and systematic process from the grassroots levels.

After completing the programme, the candidates can aspire to become Yoga Trainers/Coaches in Schools, Colleges, Sports Academies, Hospitals, Naturopathy centers, Rehabilitation centers, etc. The One Year PGDYEd Course in Yoga Education shall be offered in Theory, Practical and Teaching practices.

11. Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Nutrition

The Sports Nutrition program focuses on the scientific principles of nutrition as applied to physical activity, exercise, and athletic performance. It provides students with knowledge about macro and micronutrients, hydration, energy balance, and dietary planning for athletes. The program emphasizes optimizing performance, recovery, and overall health through proper nutritional strategies. It also addresses nutrition for different sports, age groups, and special conditions.

12. Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Management

The Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Management is designed to equip students with comprehensive knowledge and practical skills required for managing sports organizations, events, and businesses. The program integrates concepts from management, marketing, finance, law, and sports sciences to prepare students for leadership roles in the sports industry. It emphasizes strategic planning, event management, sports marketing, governance, and entrepreneurship, along with real-world exposure through internships and fieldwork.

13. Post Graduate Diploma in Strength and Conditioning

The Post Graduate Diploma in Strength and Conditioning (PGDSC) is a specialized program designed to develop advanced knowledge and practical skills in fitness training, athletic performance enhancement, and injury prevention. The program integrates scientific principles from Exercise Physiology, Biomechanics, and Sports Nutrition to prepare students for professional roles in sports performance, coaching, and rehabilitation settings.

It emphasizes evidence-based training methods, individualized program design, and the application of strength and conditioning principles to athletes and the general population. The program also focuses on developing ethical practice, leadership, and professional competence in high-performance environments.

14. Post Graduate Diploma in Computer & Sports Data Analysis

A Post Graduate Diploma (PG Diploma) in Computer and Sports Data Analysis is a specialized professional course that combines computer applications, statistics, and sports science to analyze athlete and team performance using modern technology.

The course is designed to prepare students for careers in the growing field of sports analytics, where data is used to improve performance, strategy, fitness, injury prevention, and talent identification

15. Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Journalism and Broadcasting

The Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Journalism and Broadcasting is designed to equip students with professional knowledge and practical skills required for careers in sports media. The program integrates journalism principles with specialized training in sports reporting, commentary, anchoring, digital media production, and broadcasting techniques. It prepares students to work across multiple platforms such as television, radio, print, and digital media, with a strong emphasis on ethics, accuracy, and storytelling in sports communication.

16. Post Graduate Diploma in Sports Performance and Analysis

The program in Sports Performance Analysis is designed to equip students with scientific, analytical, and technological skills to evaluate and enhance athletic performance. It focuses on the systematic observation, recording, and interpretation of performance in sports using modern tools and techniques. The program integrates principles from biomechanics, physiology, and sports psychology to help students understand performance determinants and improve training outcomes. It also emphasizes data-driven decision-making for coaches, athletes, and sports professionals.

17. P.G. DIPLOMA IN INDEGNOUS SPORTS

A Postgraduate Diploma (PG Diploma) in Indigenous Sports is a specialized one-year programme designed to provide advanced knowledge and practical training in traditional and regional games of India, such as Kabaddi, Kho Kho, Mallakhamb, and other indigenous sporting practices. The course focuses on the historical, cultural, scientific, and technical aspects of these games, including coaching methods, officiating, event management, and research. It aims to preserve and promote India's rich sporting heritage while preparing skilled professionals to contribute to sports education and development.

18. Fitness and Gym Management

The Vocational Diploma in Fitness and Gym Management is a skill-oriented programme aimed at developing practical knowledge in fitness training, gym operations, and health-related services. The programme provides training in exercise techniques, basic fitness assessment, workout planning, client handling, and gym management practices. Graduates may pursue employment as gym trainers, fitness instructors, personal trainers, and gym supervisors in fitness centres, health clubs, sports academies, and wellness institutions. The programme also promotes entrepreneurship by enabling learners to establish fitness studios, personal training services, and small-scale gym enterprises.

19. Adventure Sports and Tour Management

The Vocational Diploma in Adventure Sports and Tour Management is designed to provide professional training in adventure-based outdoor activities and tourism management. The programme emphasizes practical skills in adventure sports, safety protocols, leadership training, and tour coordination. Graduates may pursue career opportunities as adventure guides, trekking and camping instructors, outdoor activity coordinators, tour managers, and eco-tourism assistants in tourism departments, travel agencies, adventure tourism organisations, and outdoor training centres. The programme also encourages self-employment and entrepreneurship in adventure tourism services.

20. Elephant Training and Management

The Vocational Diploma in Elephant Training and Management provides specialised training in elephant care, handling practices, welfare management, and behavioural understanding. The programme is designed to develop skilled manpower for wildlife management and conservation-based employment. Graduates may pursue career opportunities as elephant management assistants, camp support staff, animal care assistants, and eco-tourism facilitators in forest departments, elephant camps, wildlife sanctuaries, conservation organisations, and nature tourism centres.

21. Bird watching and Tour Management

The Vocational Diploma in Bird Watching and Tour Management focuses on developing knowledge and field-based skills in bird identification, biodiversity awareness, nature guiding, and eco-tourism coordination. The programme prepares learners for professional engagement in nature tourism and wildlife interpretation services. Graduates may work as bird watching guides, nature tour guides, eco-tourism coordinators, wildlife documentation assistants, and tourism support staff in eco-tourism centres, wildlife sanctuaries, nature resorts, and tourism organisations. The programme also supports community-based eco-tourism initiatives and self-employment in nature guiding services.

22. Nursery and Horticulture Management

The Vocational Diploma in Nursery and Horticulture Management is designed to develop practical competencies in nursery operations, horticulture techniques, plant care, landscaping practices, and sustainable green management. The programme prepares students for employment in the horticulture and green industry sector. Graduates may pursue careers as nursery supervisors, horticulture assistants, landscaping assistants, greenhouse technicians, and garden managers in nurseries, horticulture farms, landscaping firms, government horticulture departments, and environmental development projects. The programme also promotes entrepreneurship through the establishment of plant nurseries, horticulture-based services, and green business ventures

CAREER PATHWAYS

1. Physical Education and Sports

The Five-Year Integrated Master's Programme in Physical Education and Sports provides a comprehensive foundation in physical education, sports training, coaching methods, and sports science. Graduates of this programme may pursue professional careers as Physical Education Teachers, Sports Instructors, Sports Officers, Physical Training Instructors, and Fitness Professionals in schools, colleges, universities, sports academies, and government sports departments. The programme also enables students to explore career advancement through higher studies and research in sports sciences and physical education, preparing them for academic and professional leadership roles. After completing M.P.Ed., graduates may become eligible for positions such as Assistant Professor, Sports Officer, or Physical Education Lecturer in government and private institutions, subject to applicable recruitment norms. In addition to teaching careers, graduates may also enter the sports and fitness industry as gym trainers, fitness consultants, sports coaches, athletic trainers, and wellness professionals in fitness centres, sports academies, and high-performance training institutions.

2. Sports Analytics and Mathematical Statistics

The Five-Year Integrated Master's Programme in Sports Analytics and Mathematical Statistics offers strong career prospects in data-driven sports performance and decision-making. Graduates can pursue opportunities as Sports Data Analysts, Performance Analysts, Sports Statisticians, and Research Analysts in professional sports teams, sports leagues, high-performance centres, analytics companies, and research institutions. With the increasing demand for statistical modelling and predictive analytics in sports and allied industries, the programme also provides a strong pathway for advanced studies and research in statistics, data science, artificial intelligence, and applied analytics.

3. Sports Psychology

The Five-Year Integrated Master's Programme in Sports Psychology prepares students for professional careers in athlete mental conditioning, performance enhancement, counselling, and psychological well-being management. Graduates may pursue employment as Sports Psychologists, Mental Conditioning Coaches, Athlete Counsellors, and Performance Consultants in sports academies, professional sports teams, educational institutions, fitness centres, rehabilitation units, and wellness organisations. They may also support athlete rehabilitation and recovery by addressing stress, motivation, and injury-related psychological challenges. The programme further provides scope for higher studies and research in psychology and allied behavioural sciences, enabling graduates to pursue academic, research, and specialised professional roles in sports and performance-related fields.

4. Sports Management

The Five-Year Integrated Master's Programme in Sports Management equips students with essential competencies in sports administration, event management, marketing, governance, and sports business development. Employment opportunities are available in sports marketing agencies, sports broadcasting and media companies, professional sports teams and franchises, sports goods manufacturing industries, and educational institutions such as schools, universities, and fitness centres.

5. Sports Journalism

The Five-Year Integrated Master's Programme in Sports Journalism provides strong professional pathways in sports media, communication, and digital reporting. Graduates may pursue careers as Sports Reporters, Sports Writers, Editors, Anchors, Commentators, Content Creators, and Digital Media Professionals across television networks, newspapers, radio channels, online platforms, and sports media agencies. The programme supports the development of professional ethics, communication excellence, and storytelling skills, which are highly valued in the contemporary media industry.

6. Sports Photography

RESERVATION POLICY

1. **Reservation of Seats:** Subject to revision from time to time, the Executive Council, on the recommendation of the Academic and Activity Council, shall determine and prescribe reservation of seats, maintaining consistency with the Govt. of Assam rules, for admission into different degree/diploma/certificate program of the university.
2. **Filling up of reserved seats remaining vacant:** Vacant seats reserved for SC/ST/OBC/MOBC candidates, if any, may be filled up as per Govt. of Assam rules.

REFUND OF FEE

1. Fee refunds to the students shall be regulated as per the UGC norms as revised from time to time.



CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

1. Each student shall conduct himself/herself, both within and outside the campus of the University, in a manner befitting a student of a University of National Importance. No student is expected to indulge in any activity which tends to bring down the prestige of the University. Each student shall show due respect and courtesy to the faculty members, administrators, officers, and employees of the University; and good neighborly behaviour to fellow students. They should also pay due attention and courtesy to the visitors and residents of the campus.
2. Lack of courtesy and decorum; unbecoming conduct (both within and outside the University); willful damage or removal of University property or belongings of a fellow student; disturbing fellow students in their studies; adoption of unfair means during examinations; breach of rules and regulations of the University; noisy and unseemly behavior and similar other undesirable activities shall constitute a violation of the Code of Conduct of students.
3. Violation of the Code of Conduct of students by any student shall invite disciplinary action and may merit punishment, such as reprimand, disciplinary probation, fine, being debarred from examination, debarring the use of placement services, withholding of grades, withholding of a degree, cancellation of registration and even dismissal from the university.
4. The Warden of the concerned hostel (if the hostel facility is provided) shall have the power to reprimand or impose a fine or take any other such suitable measure against any resident of the hostel who violates either the rules and regulations or the Code of Conduct pertaining to the concerned hostel.
5. The Course Instructor of a course shall have the power to debar a student from the examination in which the student is detected to be using unfair means. The Course Instructor shall have the power to take appropriate action against a student who attempts to misbehave in the class.
6. Ragging, in any form, is strictly prohibited and any violation shall be considered as a serious offence, leading to appropriate penal action as laid down from time to time by the university.
7. The Academic and Activity Council may constitute a Standing Committee to investigate the alleged misdemeanor reported and recommend a suitable course of action. The Academic and Activity Council may also prescribe the procedure for dealing with the recommendations of this Committee. Violation of the Code of Conduct of students, by a student or a group of students, can be referred to this committee by any student/faculty / any other functionary of the University.
8. In exceptional circumstances, the Chairman, Academic and Activity Council may appoint a Special Disciplinary Committee to investigate and/or recommend the action to be taken in case of any act of gross indiscipline involving a large number of students which may tarnish the image of the university.
9. The case of a defaulting student recommended for dismissal from the University shall ordinarily be referred to the Academic and Activity Council for its final decision.

10. A defaulting student who feels aggrieved with the punishment awarded may prefer an appeal to the Chairman, Academic, and Activity Council clearly the reasons why the punishment should not be awarded. The Academic and Activity Council shall prescribe the procedure to process such an appeal.
11. A student who is found guilty of some major offence may not be recommended by the Academic and Activity Council to the Executive Council for the award of a degree/ diploma/certificate even if all the academic requirements have been satisfactorily completed by the concerned student.

ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

1. Ragging of any kind is totally banned in the University as per government orders and existing laws. Any student found indulging in ragging shall be strictly dealt with as per the existing laws. As per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student/s shall be given the liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would not hesitate to expel such student/s from the University.
2. As per the UGC Letter no D.O. F. No. 1-15/2009(ARC) PT.III dated 12th June 2023 regarding the revised procedure of Anti Ragging Undertaking and Compliance submission, all the students enrolled in various programmes shall submit online Anti-Ragging undertaking in prescribed formats, which is available on the following link https://antiragging.in/affidavit_registration_disclaimer.html
