INTERNSHIP EVALUATION METHOD FOR THE STUDENTS OF B.P.E. (HONS. /HONS. WITH RESEARCH) PROGRAMME

A total of four (04) Credits has been assigned for the Internship of the students of B.P.E. (Hons. /Hons. with Research) Programme. The performance of the students during internship shall be evaluated as per the following criteria-

1. Core Evaluation Process

- **Supervisor Evaluation:** The designated Internship Supervisors will evaluate the students stationed at their respective organizations based on their daily efforts, practical output, and professional engagement.
- **External Examination:** The final assessment will be conducted through a mandatory Seminar presentation and Viva-voce Examination held at the University premises.

2. Constitution of the Expert Committee

A duly constituted Expert Committee, comprising one Internal Examiner (the respective Group Supervisor) and one External Examiner (from SASU), alongside a panel of experts from SASU will evaluate each student's work based on the following specific parameters:

- The student's activity report and the formal evaluation report provided by the Internship Supervisor.
- The visual/structural format of the presentation and the academic quality of the student's final report.
- The visible acquisition and application of a professional teaching skill/soft skills/life skills set by the student.
- The originality of the work and any innovative contributions made during the internship.
- The overall attendance record maintained by the student throughout the internship tenure.
- Submission of completion certificate from the Internship providing organization.



3. Distribution of weightage

The distribution of weightage for the valuation of Internship shall be:

- Internal Assessment: 40%
- External Assessment: 40%
- Viva voce/Seminar presentation: 20%

4. Submission of Results:

Upon completion of the Viva voce and Report verification process, the final consolidated Grades shall be compiled and submitted jointly by both the Internal and External Examiners to the Head of the Department concerned for onward submission to the Controller of Examinations.
